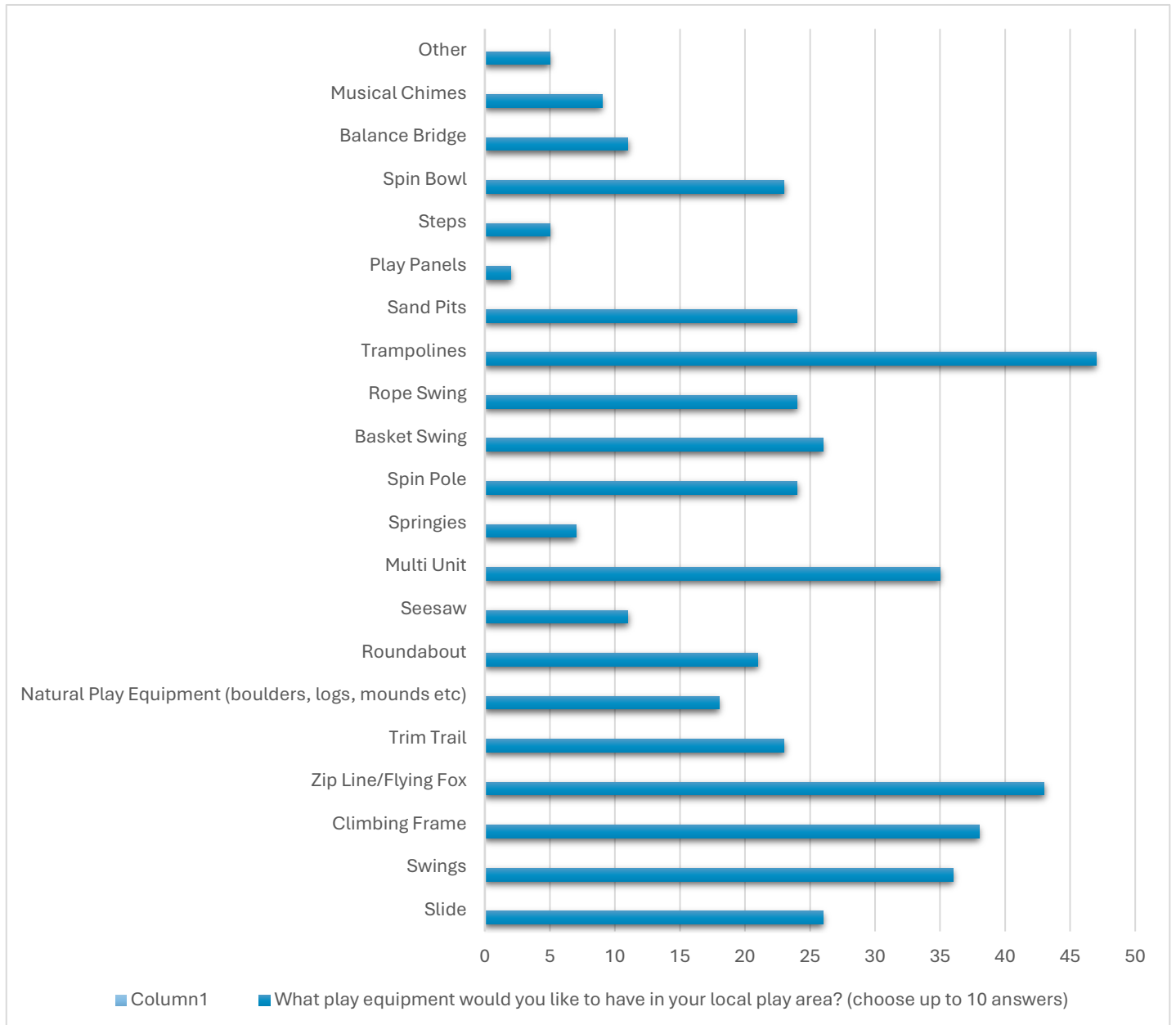

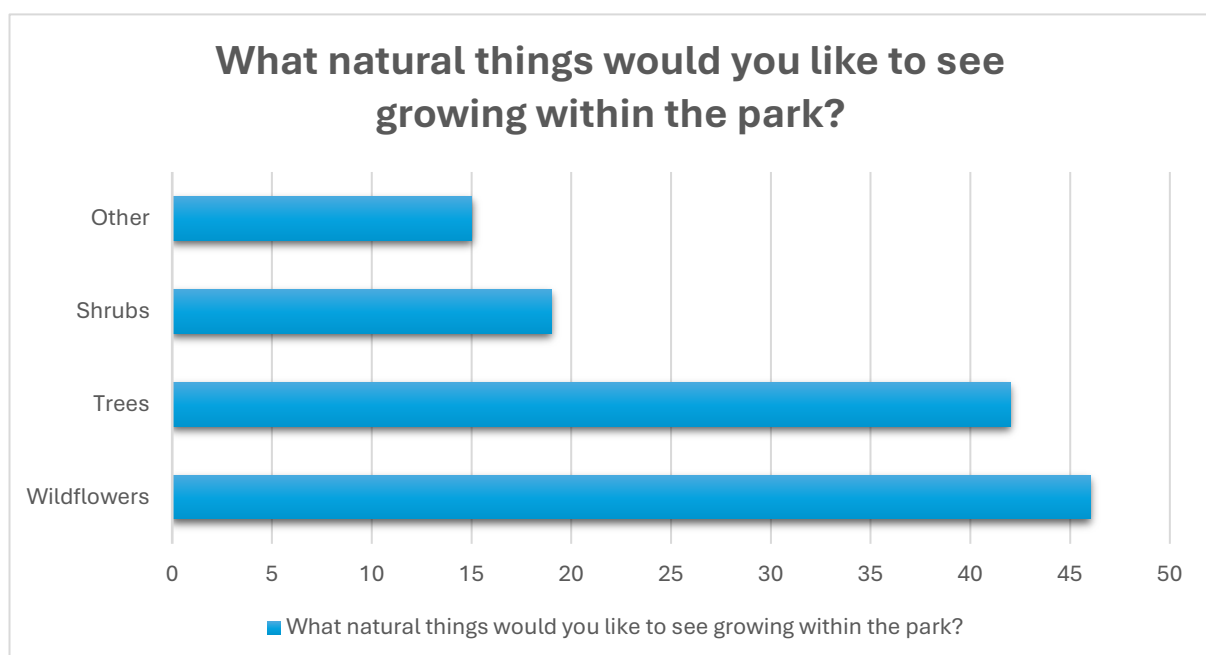
1. What play equipment would you like to have in your local play area? (choose up to 10 answers).

Other ideas include astro turfed pitch, a rock wall, a basketball court and a spinning swing.

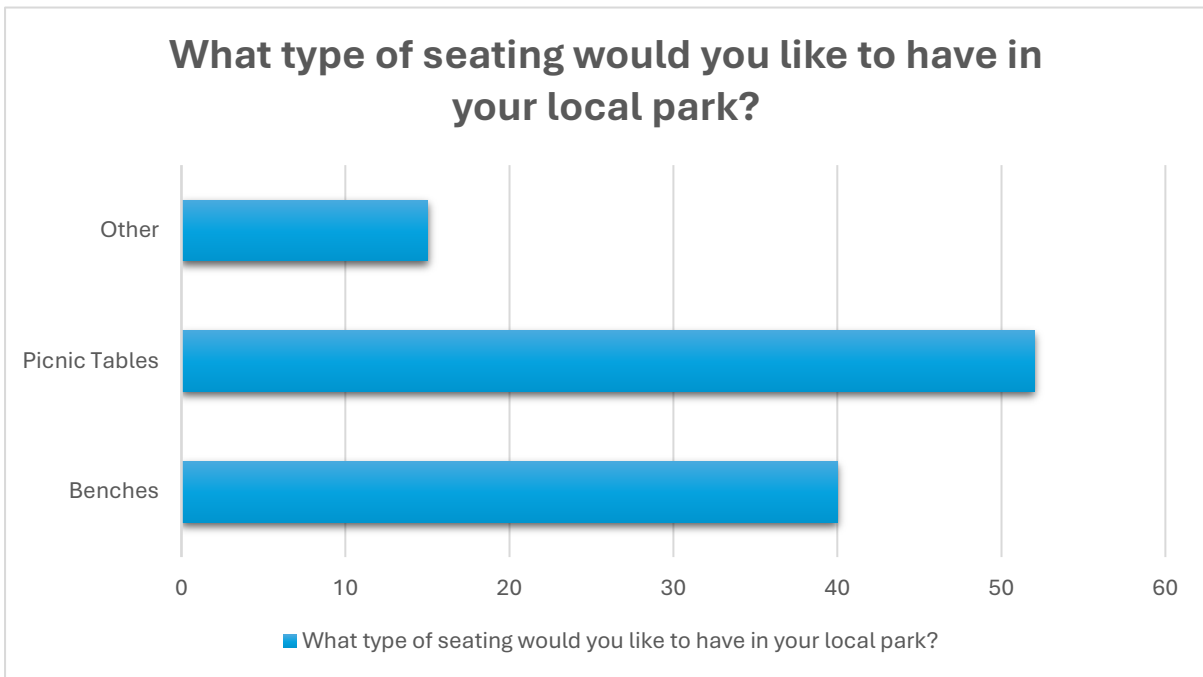
2. What natural things would you like to see growing within the park?
