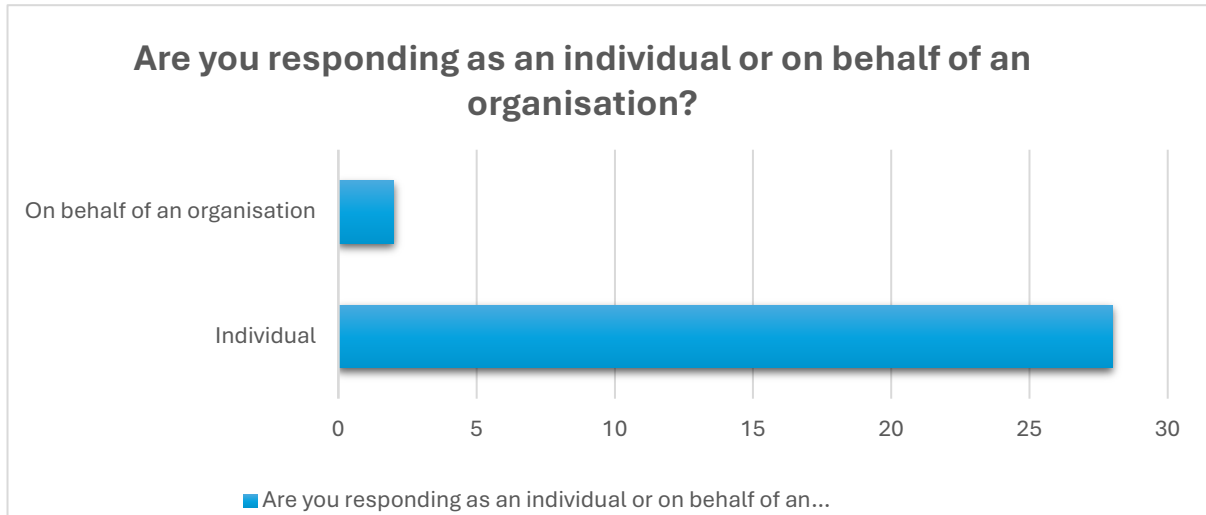


# Participate Plus: Victoria Park Play Area Upgrade: Requirements Survey Results

## 1. Are you responding as an individual or on behalf of an organisation?

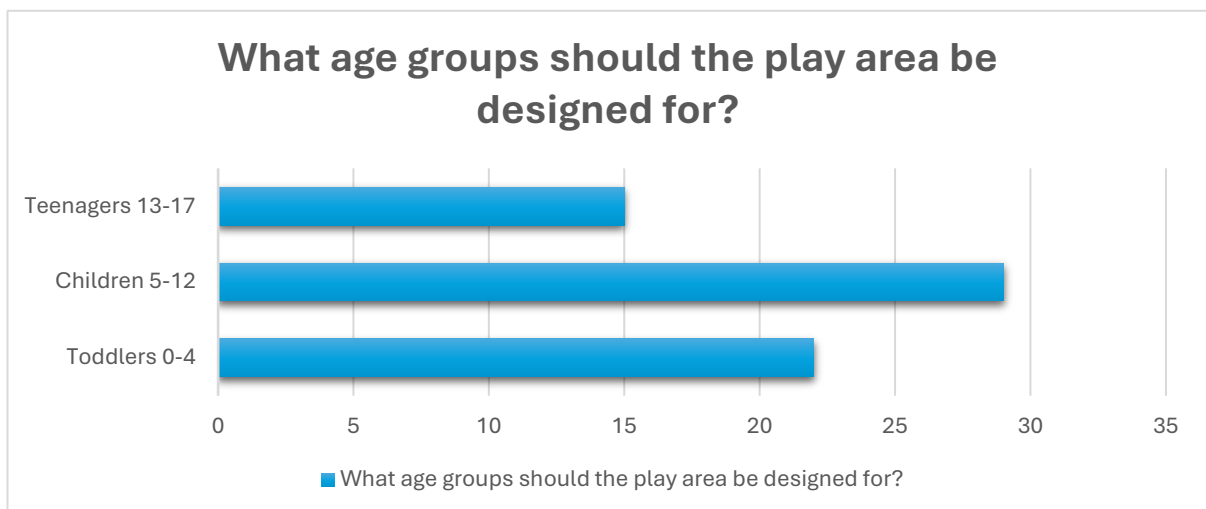
There were 30 responses to this question

## 2. What age groups should the play area be designed for?

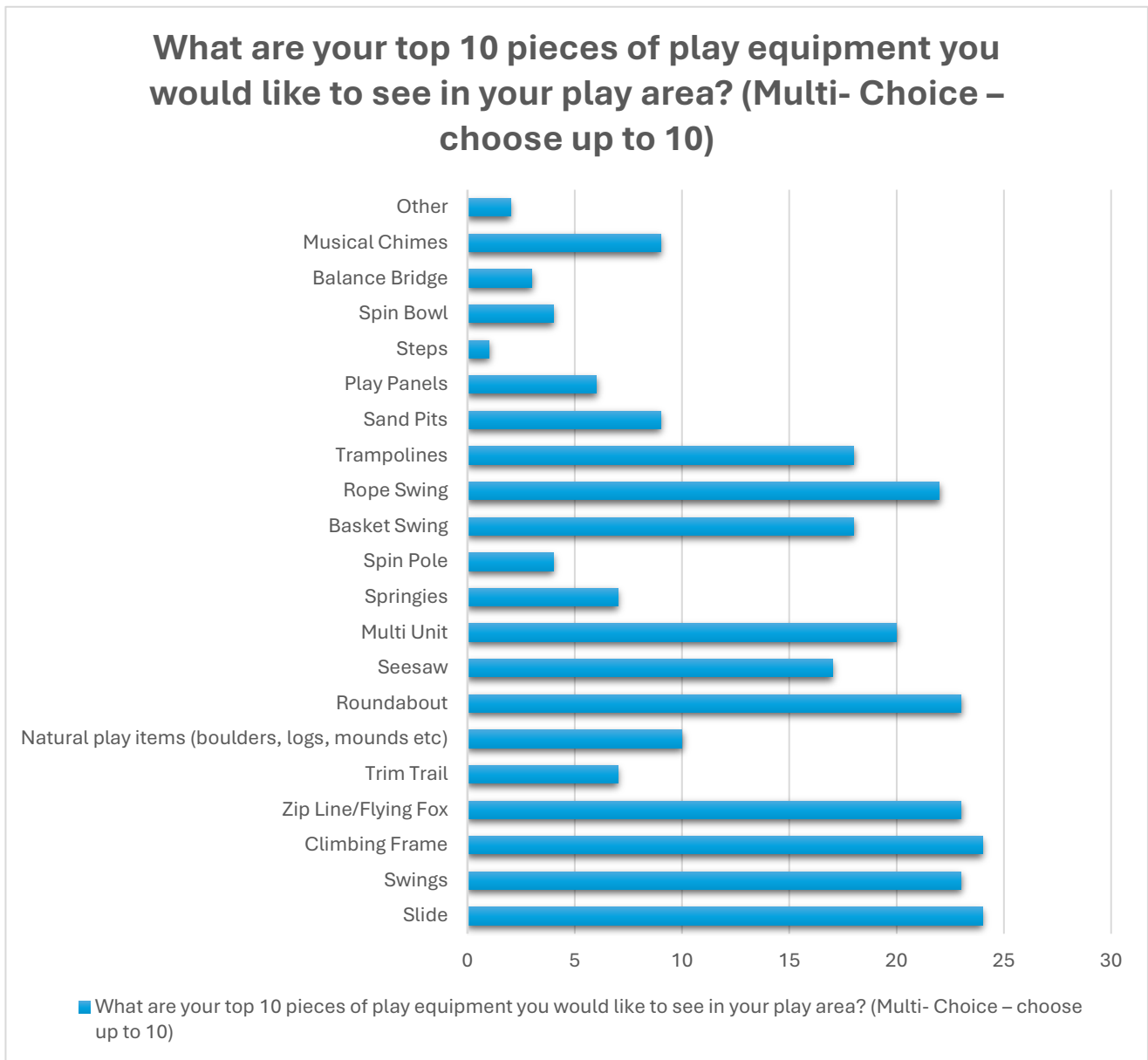

#### 4. Would you like to see more shrubs tree and wildflowers growing within the park?

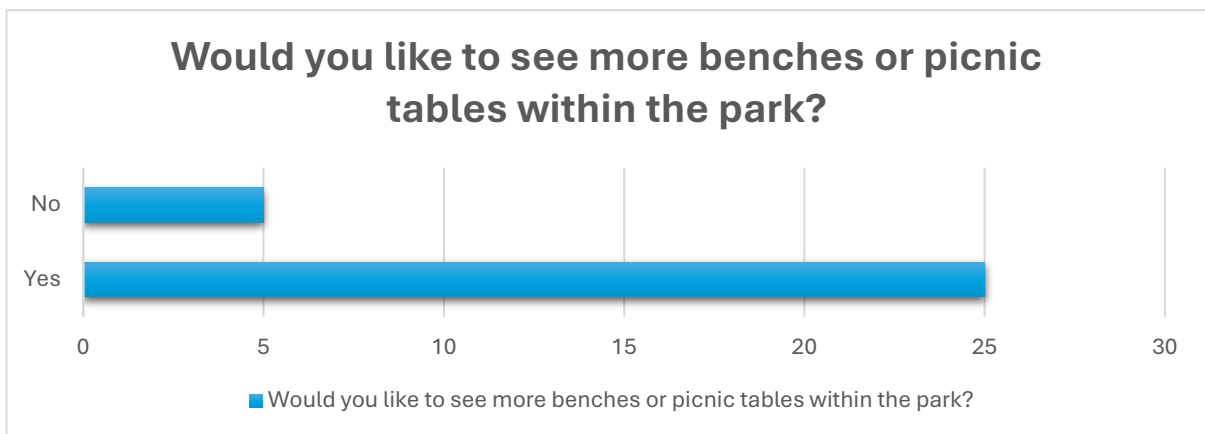
