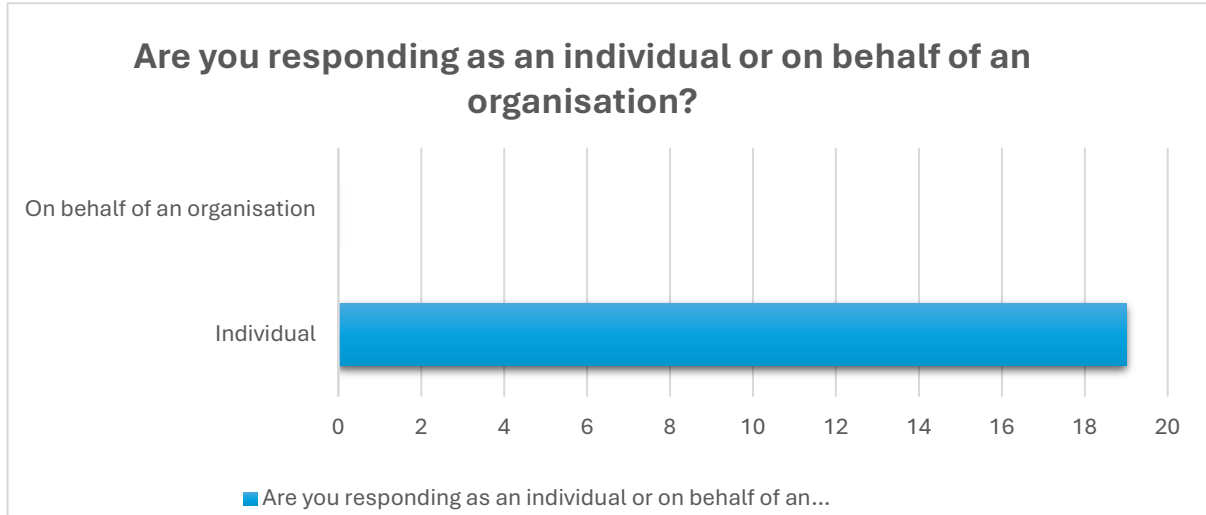

1. Are you responding as an individual or on behalf of an organisation?

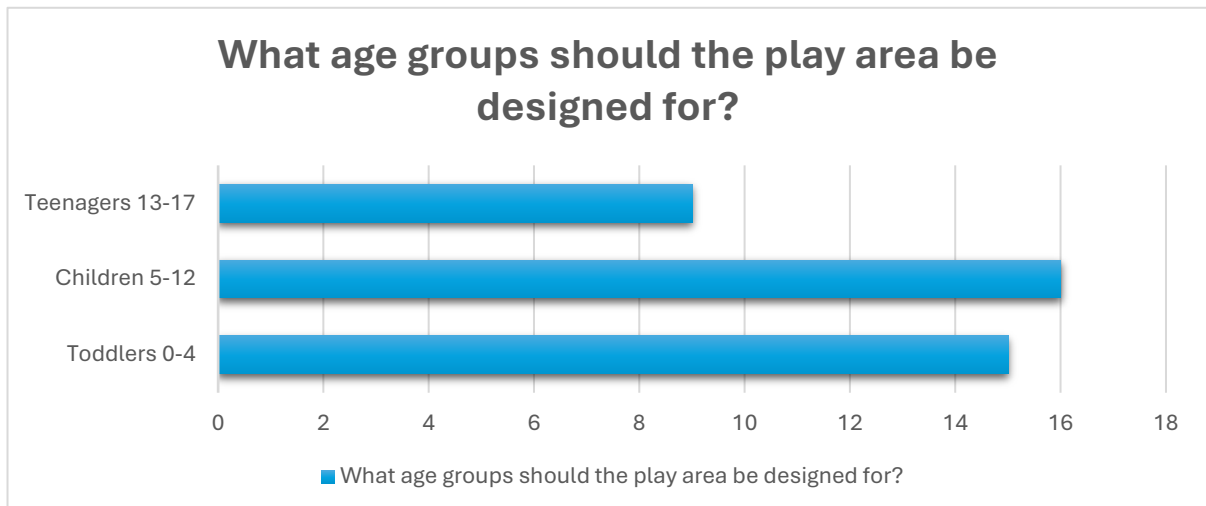

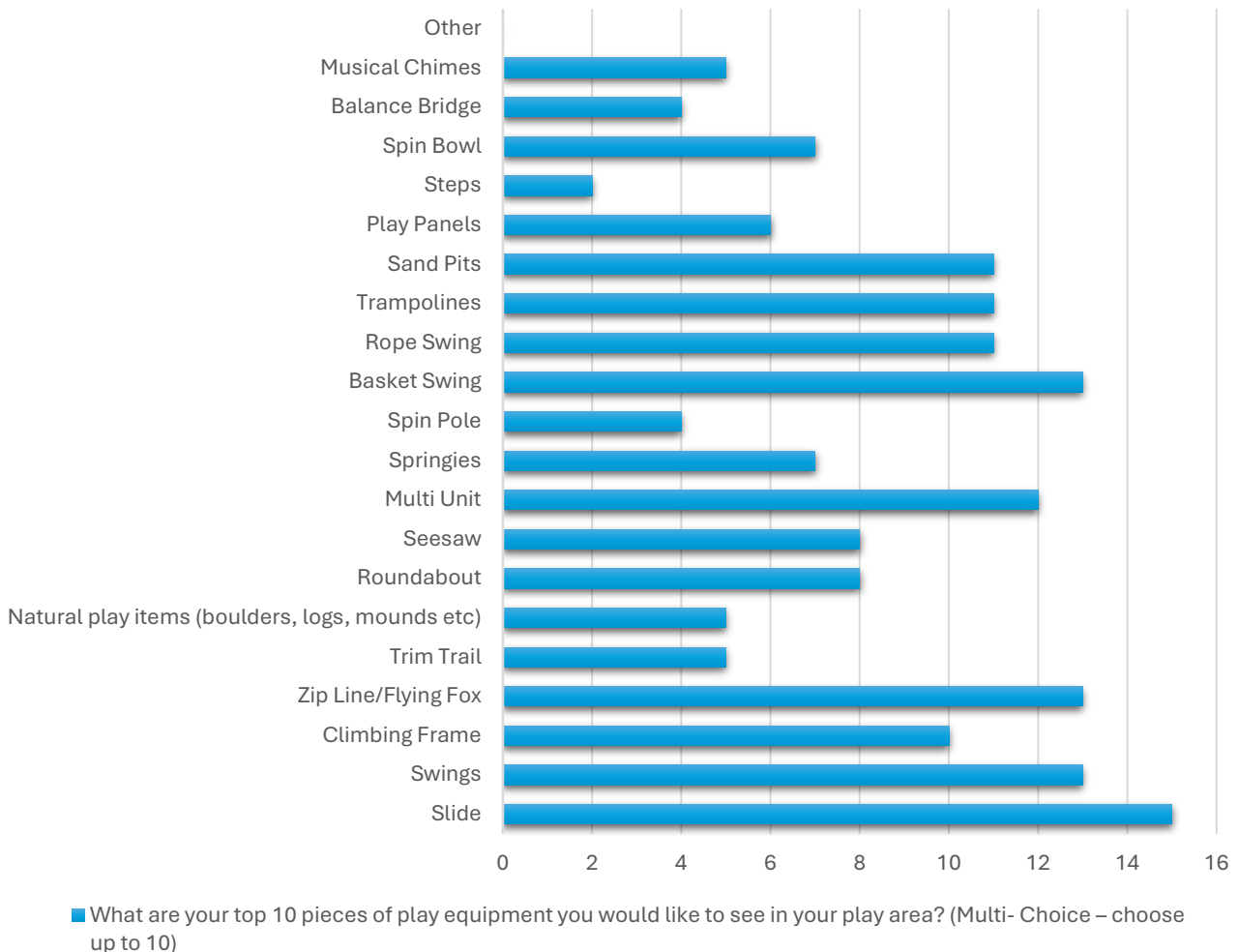

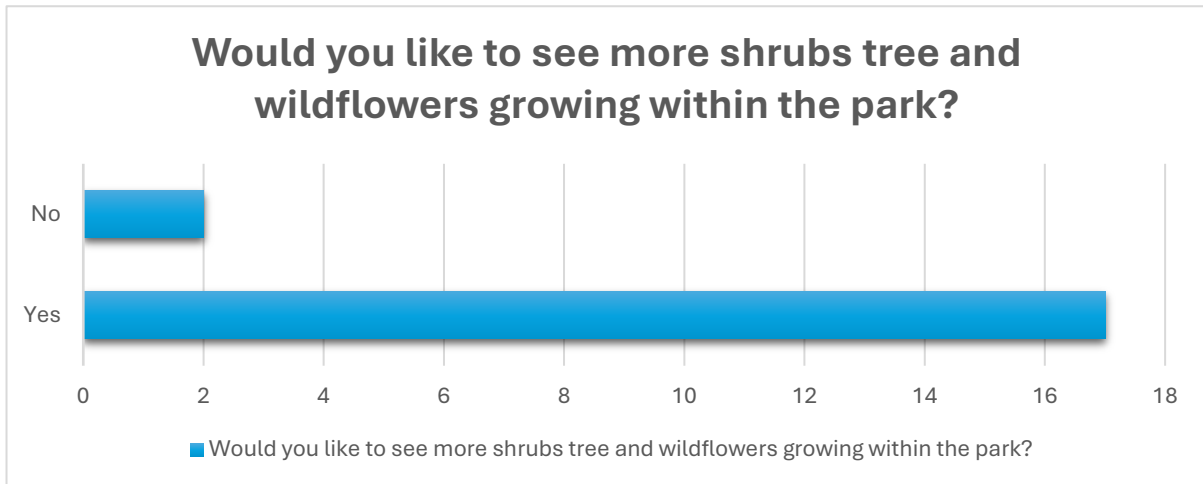

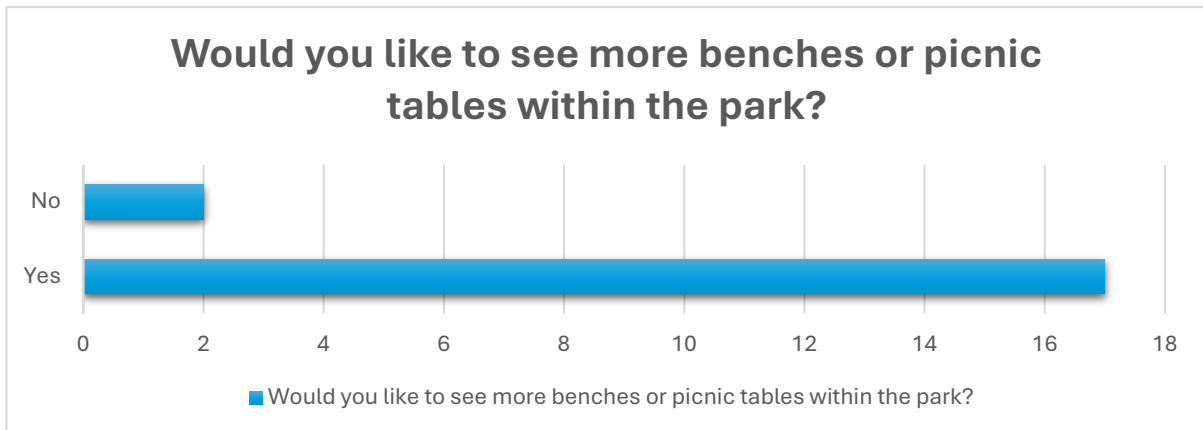
