





Softworks

-  Beech hedge





Existing features

-  Trees to be removed









Hardworks

-  Renewed hazard warning surfacing at crossing points
-  Resin bound gravel
-  HRA surfacing with white chippings & new pre-cast concrete pin kerbs
-  Concrete block paving
-  Concrete block paving forming soldier bond around built features/ edges of block surfacing

Street Furniture

-  Existing benches relocated
-  Timber seating built on existing wall
-  Flag pole
-  Litter bin

Other works

-  Proposed decorative railing painted to match existing railings.
-  Existing circular metal handrail to be repainted
-  Existing decorative railings to be repainted
-  Existing damaged inner kerbs to be replaced with new
-  Existing Road Signs and supporting columns to be fully cleaned
-  Existing damaged bollards to be replaced
-  Existing lampost columns to be fully cleaned
-  Existing illuminated road traffic signs to be fully cleaned

Hardworks & Street Furniture



The regeneration works on the Merorials Gardens focus on providing accessible access to all parts of the site, improving the surfacing throughout the park, introducing high quality surfacing around the memorials to draw attention to them. The seating areas are improved with new benches. New shrub planting, a biodiverse wildflower meadow, and replacement of some conifers with deciduous trees are proposed to improve the visual appeal of the gardens and enable passive surveillance.

Works around the road include replacement of the tactile surfacing at the crossing points, replacing/uprighting the bollards, resurface the muddy areas and replace some of the broken road kerbs. Street signs and lighting columns will also be cleaned to improve the overall amenity of the area.
