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### Proposed actions for Economic Activity

*The Falkirk Local Employability Partnership (LEP) is a collaborative initiative aimed at improving employability services in the Falkirk area. Its purpose is to provide tailored support to individuals seeking employment, training, or education, ensuring that they receive the right assistance at the right time. Partners include Falkirk Council, NHS Forth Valley, Forth Valley College, Forth Valley Chamber of Commerce, CVS Falkirk, Skills Development Scotland and the Department for Work and Pensions.*

- Falkirk Council's Employment & Training Unit (ETU) will continue to build on the parents' programmes currently being delivered in Camelon.
- ETU will continue to work with and support local employers (in partnership with Business Gateway) to provide advice and guidance around recruitment, workforce development and employer incentives.
- The Local Employability Partnership will increase the supported employment programme locally to target Camelon, providing support to adults with learning disabilities and autism. The support programme will move participants closer to the labour market, into training, employability support, further and higher education and jobs.
- The local Employability Partnership will increase commissioned mental health resources within the Camelon area to support improvement of self-management and resilience, while encouraging engagement with employability support, training opportunities, employment and/or further and higher education opportunities.
- Outcomes for school leavers are poorer in Camelon than in the rest of Falkirk. The Local Employability Partnership will increase resources to target young people in the Camelon area who are currently disengaged. The service will provide support and personal development to progress young people towards employability support, training opportunities, employment and/or further and higher education opportunities.
