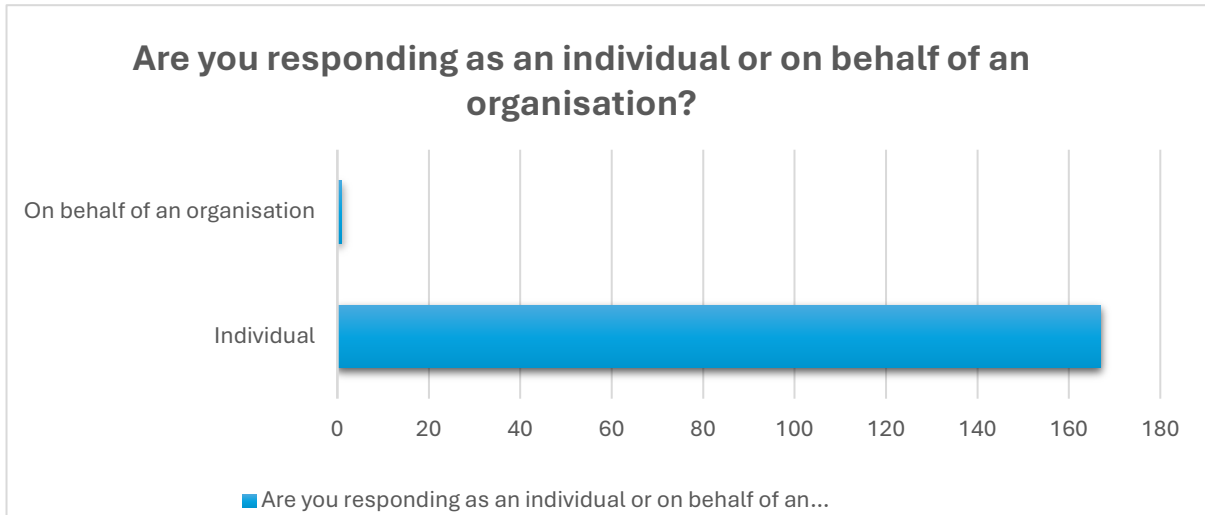

1. Are you responding as an individual or on behalf of an organisation?

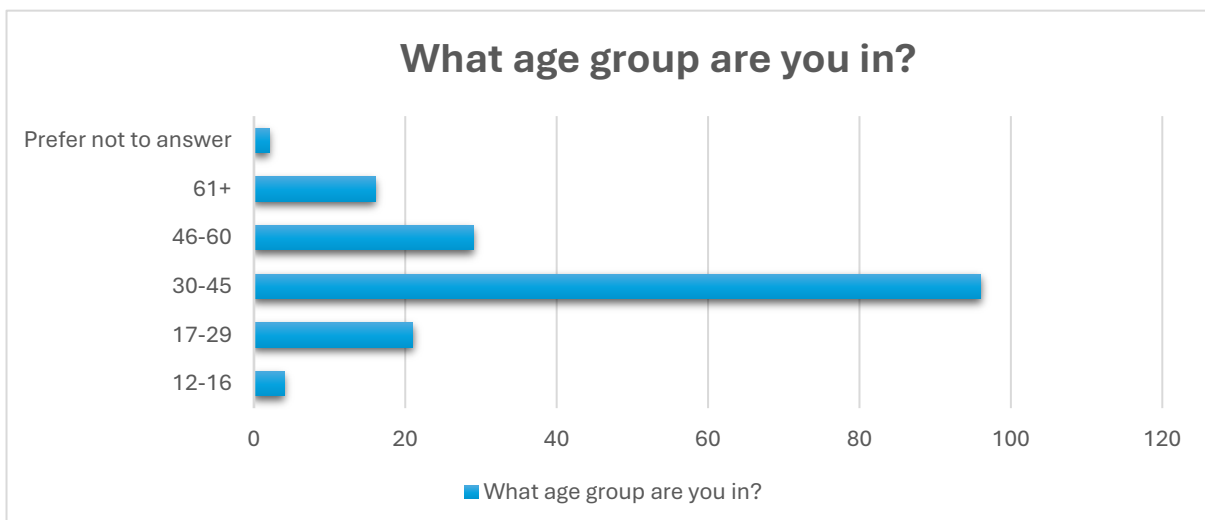

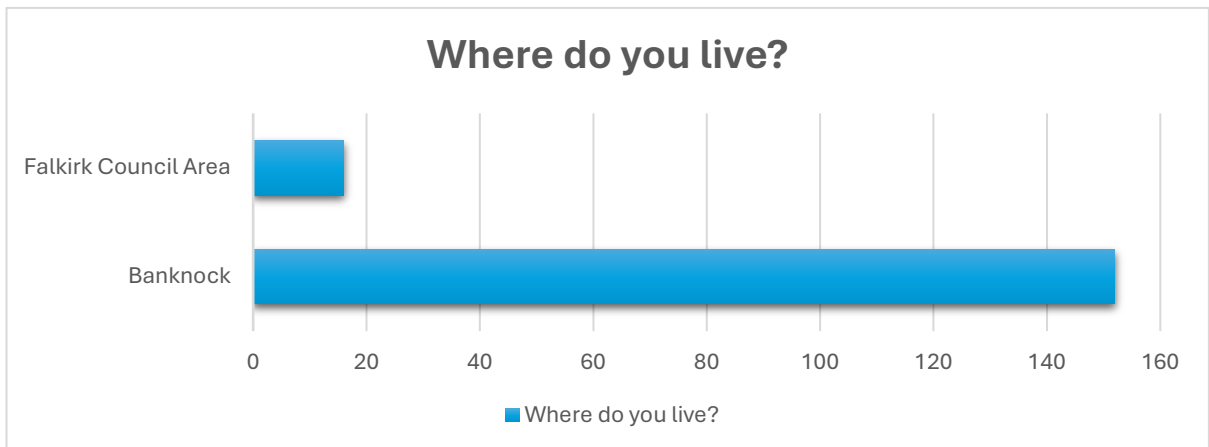

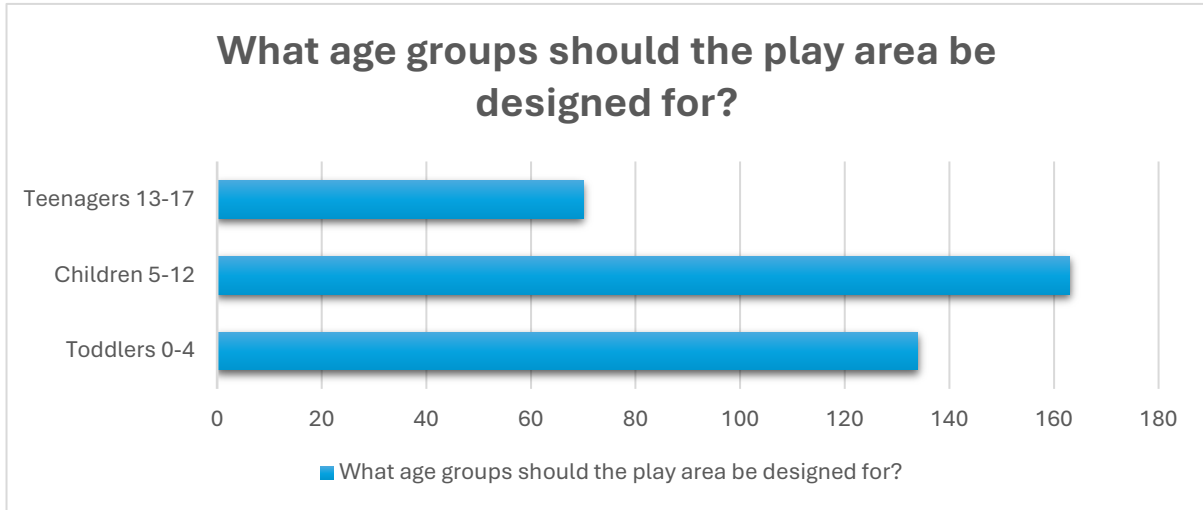

4. What age groups should the play area be designed for?

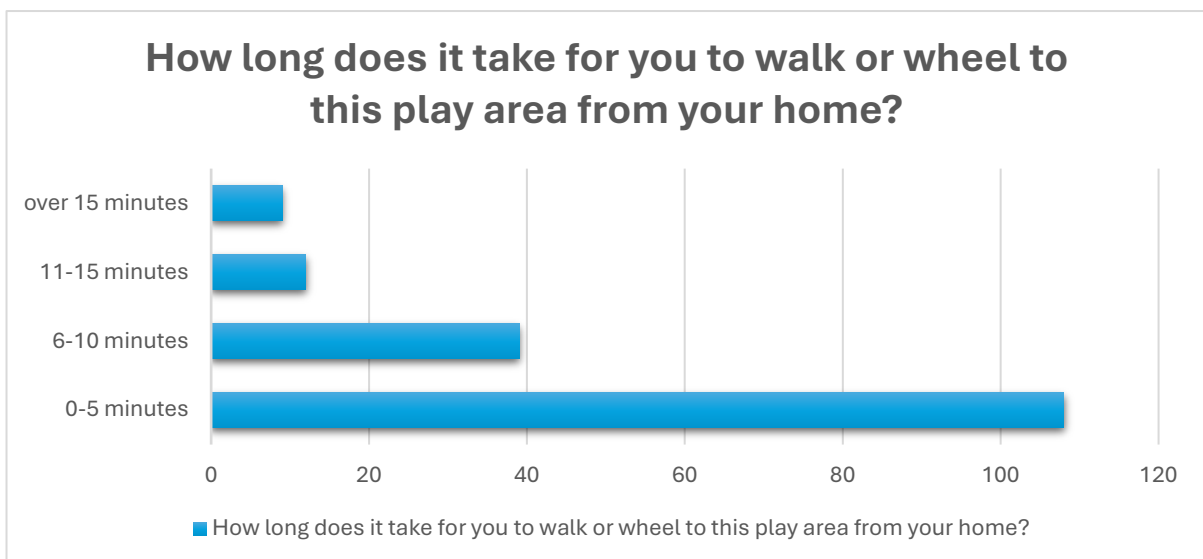

5. How long does it take for you to walk or wheel to this play area from your home?

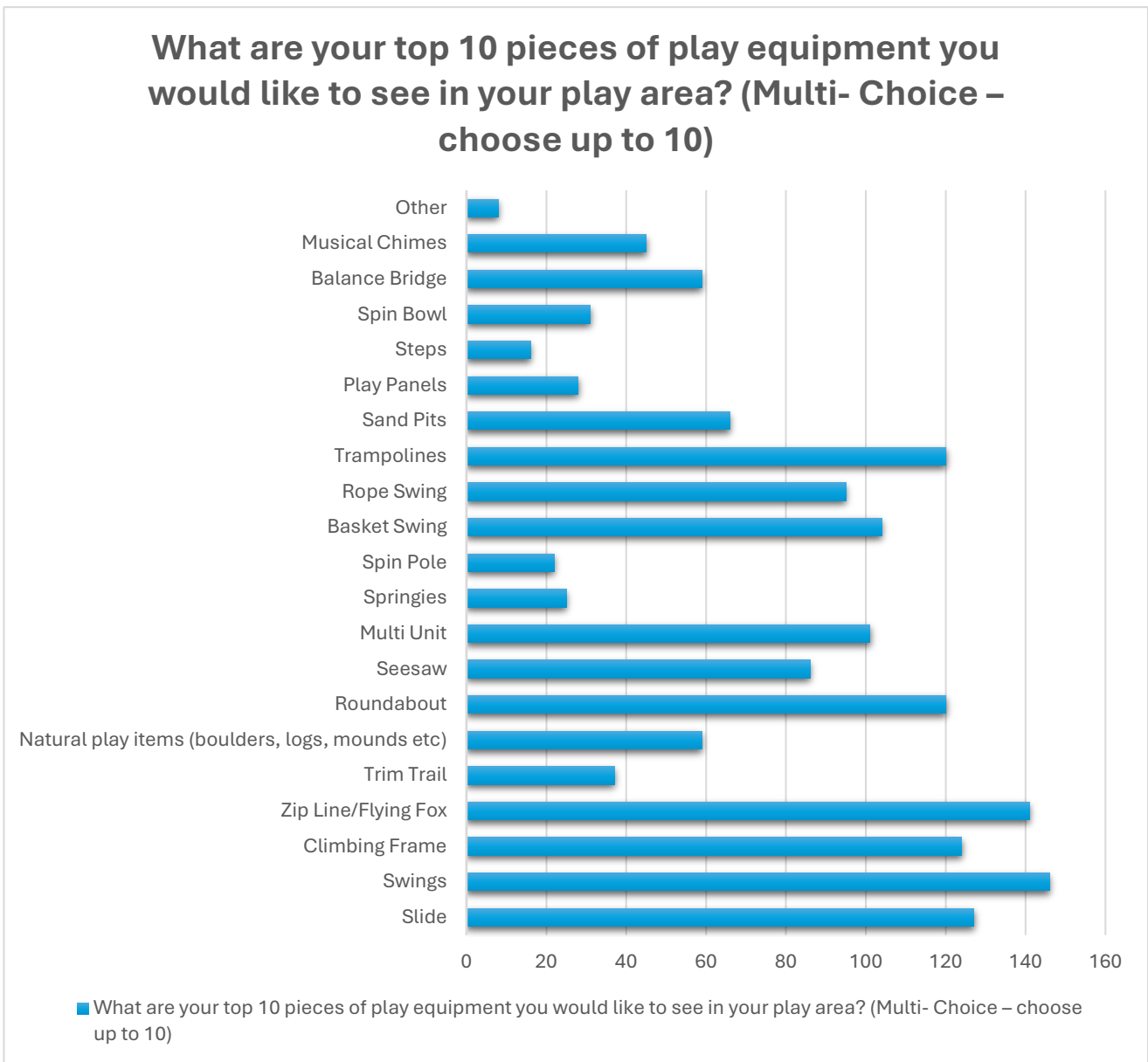

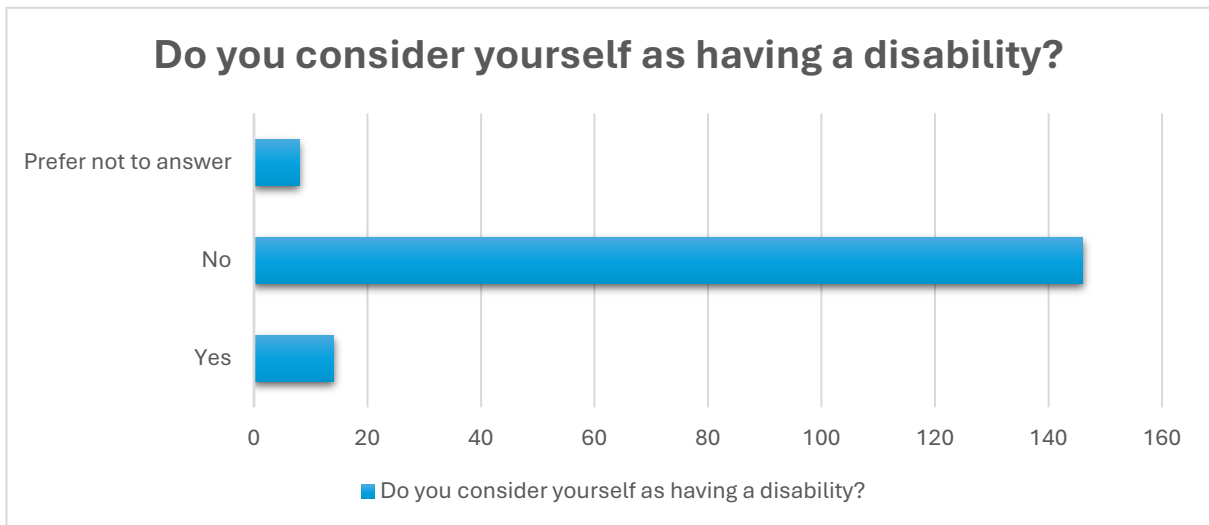

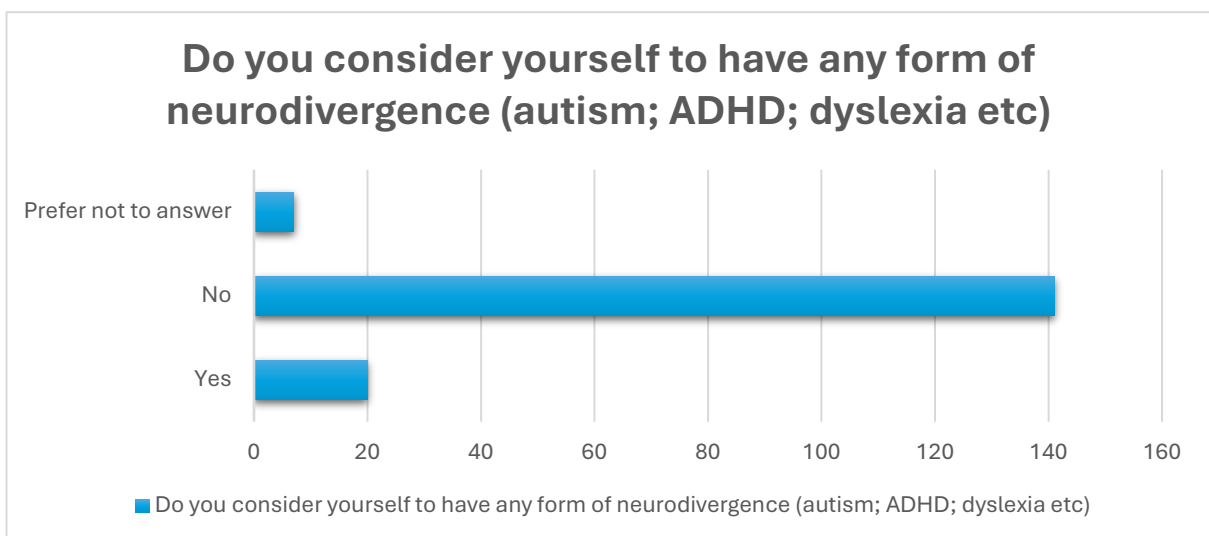

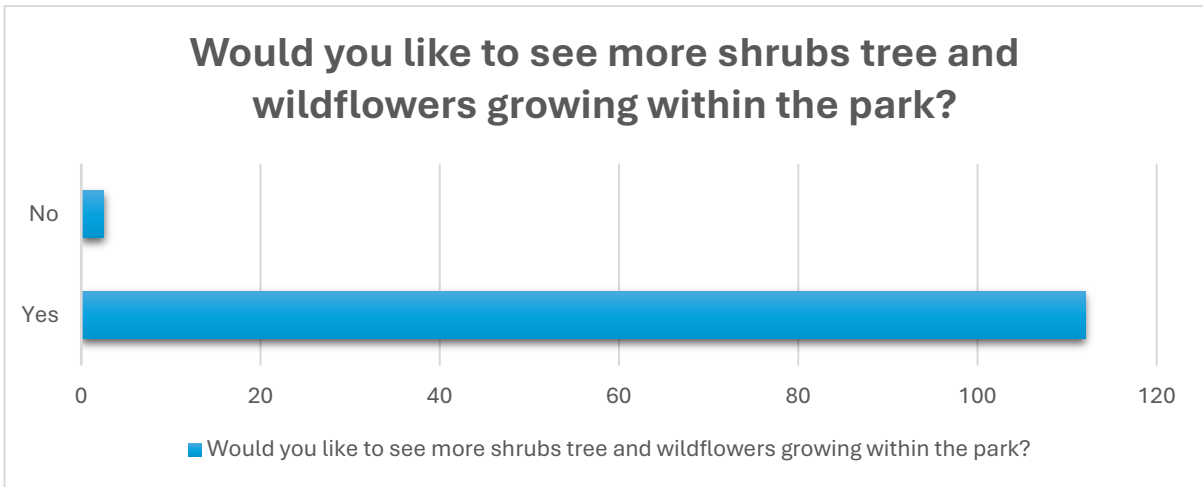

9. Would you like to see more shrubs tree and wildflowers growing within the park?

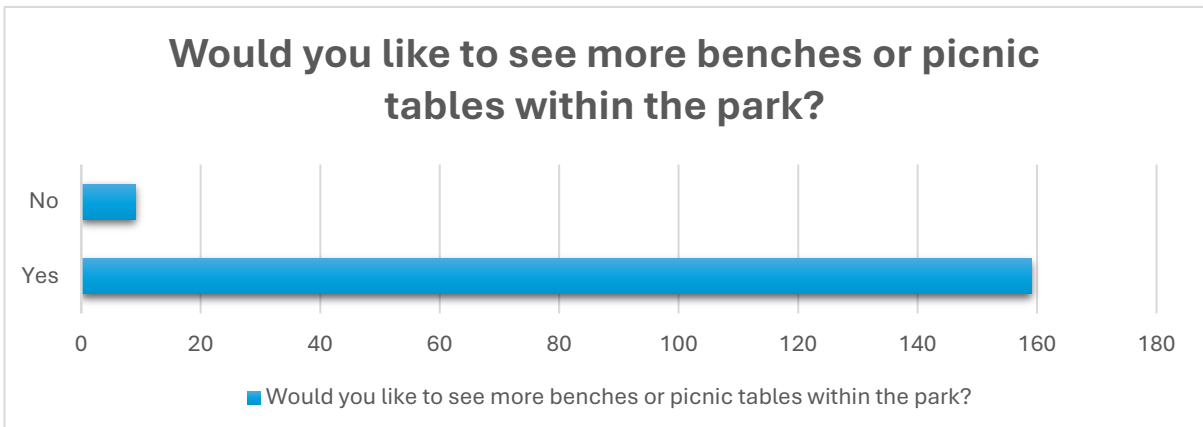

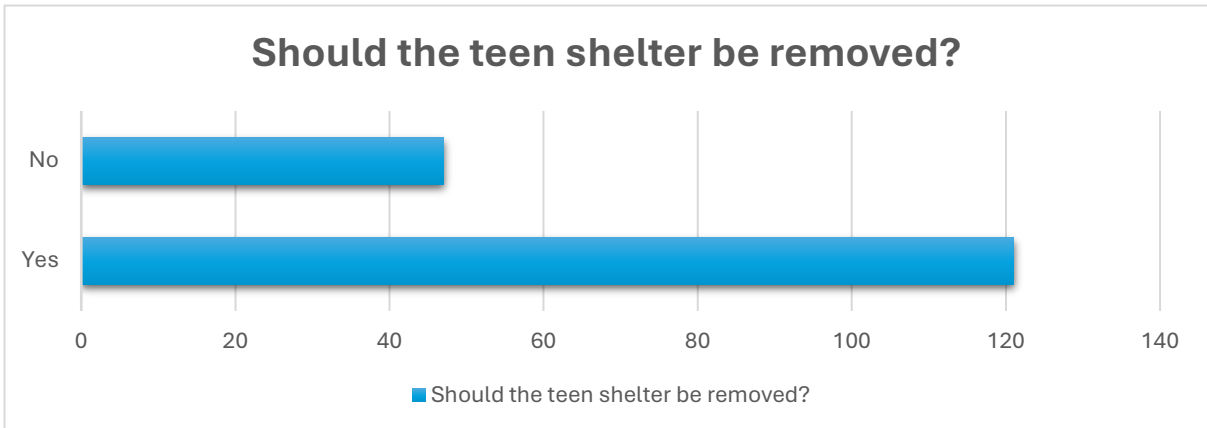

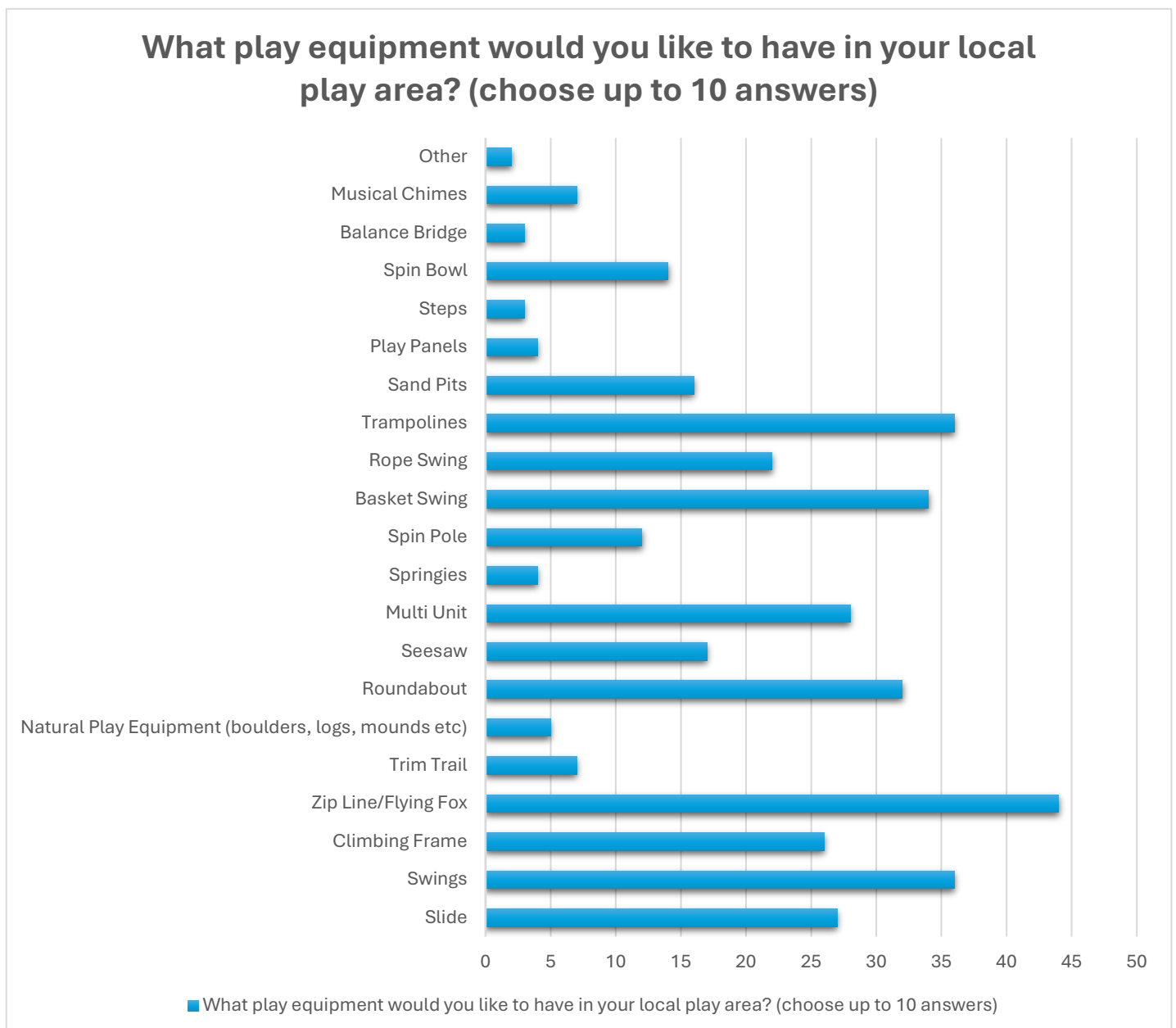

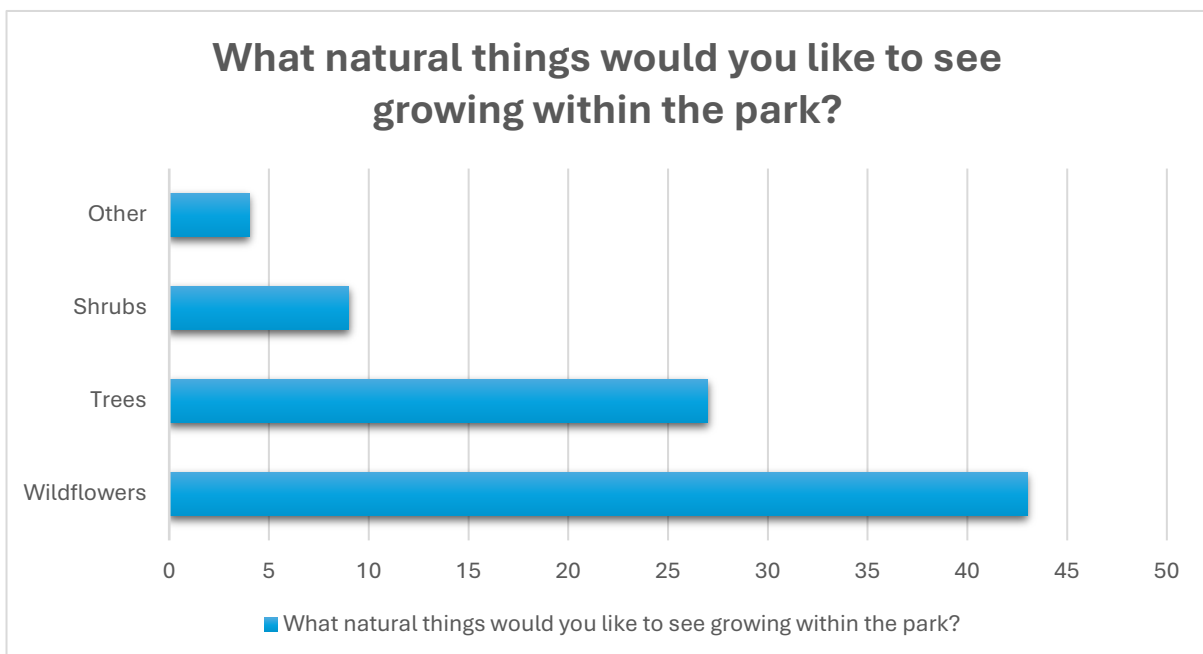

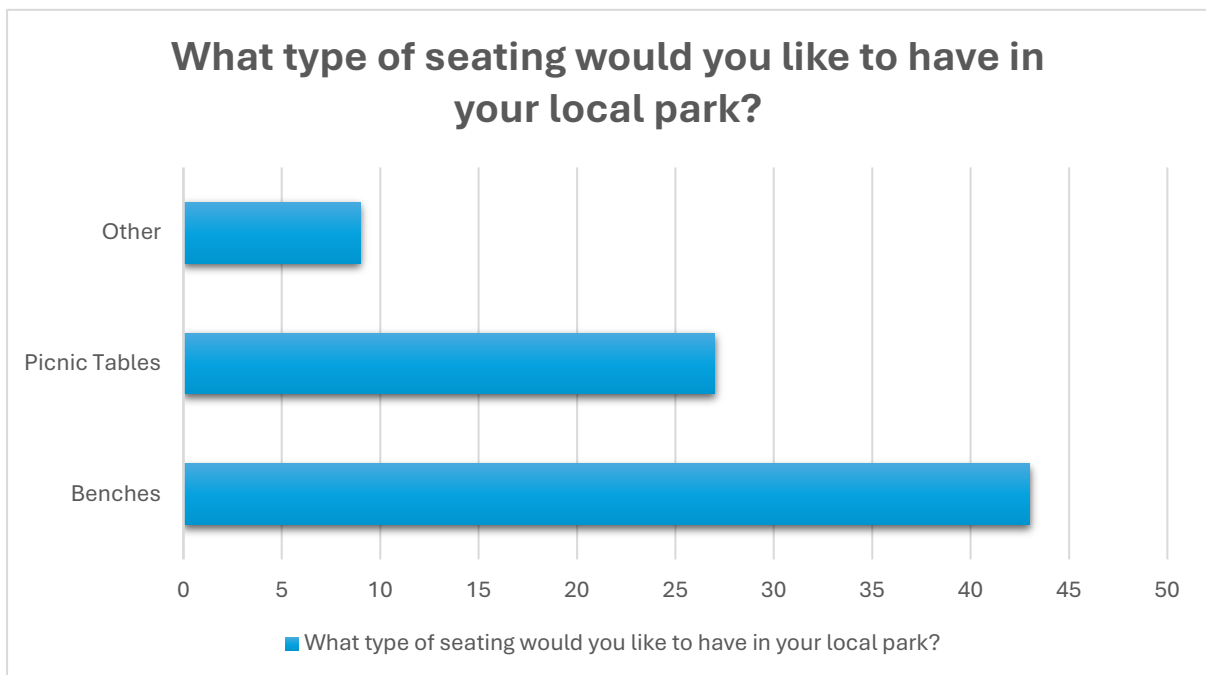
